

Description:

This one (1) day face to face course will provide Managers and Supervisors with the necessary skills and knowledge to participate effectively in Occupational Health and Safety matters at their workplace. The foundation of this course is based on the practical application of the Occupational Health and Safety legislation, including roles and responsibilities.

- Know what enforcement measures are in place.

- Apply the principles of Risk Management, including identifying hazards and assessing and controlling risks.
- Create and implement a critical risk register.
- Understand which incidents are notifiable under the legislation.
- Develop and implement strategies to make their workplace a safer environment.
