



Health & Safety Representative (HSR) Training – Five Day Course

Description: This **five (5) day** SafeWork NSW approved training course aims to provide participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to fulfil their role as Health & Safety Representatives (HSRs), meeting the requirements of the legislation and influence health and safety outcomes in their workplace.

- Identify the main provisions of the legislation governing health and safety in the workplace.
- Describe the duties of the various stakeholders that influence WHS.
- Outline the role of unions and WHS entry permit holders under the WHS Act; HSRs, Health and Safety Committees (HSCs) and other authorized representatives.
- Describe the powers of HSRs issuing PINs and directing the ceasing of unsafe work.
